

The biggest threat to slow lorises is the illegal pet trade. Before slow lorises are sold, traders cut or pull out their teeth so that they don't bite their new owners. Because of this, many of them die of various infections and as many as 90% do not survive transportation.



By purchasing a slow loris, sharing videos with a slow loris and taking pictures with a slow loris as a tourist attraction you support this illegal trade!
